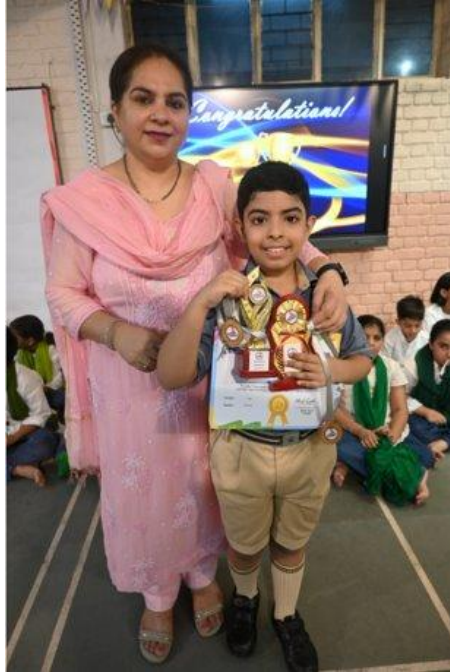

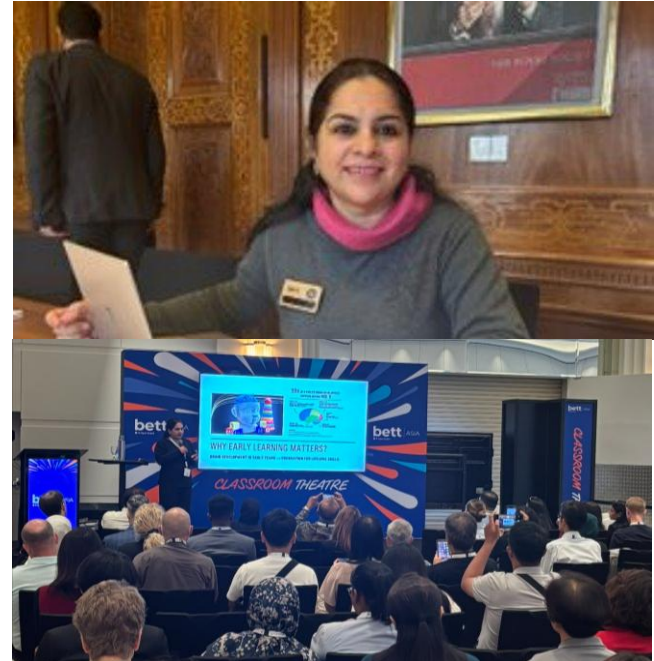

The irreplaceable role of teachers in digital learning environments

Throughout our discussions, participants repeatedly emphasised that teachers provide pedagogical expertise, social-emotional support, contextual adaptability, and other aspects that no technology can replicate. **Sonia Wadhwa, Principal of Salwan Junior School, India, captured this sentiment eloquently: "A teacher excites a student to pick up the book and read it; the EdTech tool helps the student read it more fluently and with the correct pronunciation."**

This recognition of teachers' irreplaceable role must be central to all EdTech development and implementation. While technology can automate certain tasks and enhance learning experiences, it cannot replace the human connection, inspiration, and nuanced understanding that skilled teachers bring to education. As we navigate digital transformation in education, we must ensure that technology serves to amplify rather than diminish teachers' essential contributions.



Public-Private Partnerships as a path forward

The roundtable explored how Public-Private Partnerships (PPPs) could make EdTech more accessible and sustainable. **Nasser Faqih, Chief of Strategic Partnerships for Education Cannot Wait, emphasised that innovative partnerships are becoming essential, particularly as humanitarian assistance and official development funding face significant cuts.**

"In crisis-affected and fragile contexts, where education systems are weak or entirely dependent on aid, traditional funding models are no longer sufficient to sustain teacher training and salaries," Faqih noted. He explained that donors are increasingly shifting from demand-driven to supply-driven approaches, prioritising specific countries and themes that align with their national interests.

Mrs. Sonia Wadhwa, published an article and emphasized Salwan's focus on teacher training, digital inclusion pedagogies, and co-creating impactful learning experiences.

Looking forward

While the teacher shortage crisis cannot be solved overnight, this roundtable has established a clear pathway for meaningful change. Success will require sustained commitment from all stakeholders and a fundamental shift in how we approach EdTech implementation.

The evolution of funding models will be crucial. As Nasser Faqih noted: "The decline in ODA means donors are looking for new ways to leverage limited funds through innovative financing mechanisms. These include debt swaps, loan guarantees, blended finance, and partnerships with investment funds, corporations, and international financial institutions."

"I pledge to contribute by engaging in teacher-training programmes and creating opportunities that amplify learning through digital inclusion pedagogies. I will work to empower teachers to co-create with technology while helping schools develop effective digital transformation and retention strategies. My commitment extends to suggesting context-specific tools and writing guided content and case studies that demonstrate how technology, when used in specific ways, can be a genuine game-changer for education."
