Subject: Important School Update: Implementation of Hybrid Learning

Dear Parents,

In continuation of the advisory issued by the competent authorities via circular No.DE.23(28)/Sch.Br./2026/49 and in compliance with the prevailing guidelines, the school will operate in **hybrid mode** from **Monday, 19 January 2026**.

Hybrid mode implies that **physical classes will continue campus** for students who are willing and able to attend school, while academic continuity will be ensured for students who are unable to attend due to health-related concerns.

The operational details are as follows:

On-Campus Physical Classes

Students who attend school physically will follow the regular timetable and routine classroom teaching.

Nursery & Kindergarten

Timing: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Classes I to V

Timing: 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (as per the regular timetable)

Academic Support for Students at Home

For students who are unwell or advised to stay at home, teachers will share the **classwork and key learning points on Microsoft Teams under the “Classwork” section**, enabling them to stay connected with ongoing lessons.

In addition, if students studying from home require further clarification or academic support, **doubt-clearing sessions may be requested from the respective subject teachers**. These sessions will be conducted on **Saturdays between 12:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m., as per mutual availability and prior intimation**.

The school strongly believes that regular physical attendance plays a crucial role in students' overall development- academic, social, and emotional. We therefore encourage parents to send their children to school, wherever possible, while also respecting individual health considerations.

We seek your continued cooperation and support in ensuring a balanced, safe, and meaningful learning experience for all our students.
